CITY LIGHTS FOUNDATION

Over the past six years, Garver's Tulsa office has proudly partnered with the City Lights Foundation of Oklahoma to support individuals experiencing homelessness through relational service opportunities. Through GarverGives, employees routinely sponsor the Night Light Tulsa event, a gathering under a downtown highway overpass where homeless neighbors can come for many different services.

Lawton

I AM STEM

Garver and I AM STEM work together to invest in the next generation of innovators through its summer program in Lawton, OK. Through GarverGives, Garver's Transportation, Water, and Aviation Teams lead activities that demonstrated STEM concepts. The students explore water filtration, aerospace, roadways, and bridges. During tours of the water treatment plant and the airport, the kids interact with real professionals in the field to see what careers in aviation, transportation, and water look like.
